

Park Rules

Cancelation/Change policy: Our cancellation/change policy is 24 hours notice. You must notify us by 3:00 p.m. the day before your arrival if you need to cancel or change a reservation, otherwise you forfeit the total amount of a one-night stay.

Damage Deposit: A damage deposit of \$250 (pre-authorization) will be held on the Guest credit card (no Visa/Mastercard, debits or prepaid). This hold will be released upon check out, providing there are no damages, excess cleaning required or smoking in the cabin. Credit cards used for preauthorized hold must match the name used for the reservation.

Excessive cleaning fees will apply when:

- > Smoking: There is no smoking or vaping allowed inside the cabins. You may do so on your porch or in your outside area.
- Cigarette Butts: Please do not throw cigarette butts on the ground or in the garden beds. You are to throw butts into your firepit. Should there be an excessive number of butts around the cabin or in the garden bed, an excessive cleaning charge shall apply.
- > Garden Beds: Do not dump grease or any debris into garden.

Parking is only permitted in designated space – guests may *not* drive through the cabin area or glamping sites. One parking space is included in your reservation (additional vehicles and day visitors are subject to Day Use Fee).

Check in time: between 3 PM and 9 PM from May 1 – October 31 and between 3 PM and 7 PM from November 1 – April 30.

Check out time: before 11 AM. Please tidy your cabin (pick up garbage around the cabin and place it in the bin and wash any dishes you may have used). An additional cleaning fee will be applied for an especially messy cabin.

Day visitors: visitors are permitted in the park but must check in at the office and leave by 9:00 PM. A Day Use fee of \$10 per vehicle applies.

Campfires: please keep all fires in your firepit and do not leave the fire unattended. Do not put glass, tinfoil, cans, etc. into your firepit. Do not bring outside firewood into the park – we sell firewood at the office. This is to prevent invasive species from entering the grounds and infecting the natural environment of Chiefswood Park.

Waste: please help us keep our park clean by not littering and by placing any garbage in the bins or dumpster. Chiefswood Park also recycles so you may place recycling in appropriate bins.



Trees & wildlife: please respect Mother Earth and our property. Do not destroy wildlife, trees or damage property. Please do not cut or break branches off trees, peel off bark or remove any artifacts.

Quiet hours: Quite times are from 10 PM – 8 AM. If you choose to spend time outside by your firepit at night, please keep your voice down and turn down your music. Any excessive noise that results in complaints from other guests will be subject to a noise fee charged to your credit card or possible eviction without refund.

Pets: pets are permitted in the park and in designated pet-friendly cabins only. If you are found to have a pet in a cabin not designated pet-friendly a \$100 cleaning fee will apply. Pets must be on a leash at all times, cleaned up after and not left unattended at any time. If your pet makes excessive noise that results in complaints from other guests, a noise fee will apply, and Guests will face possible eviction without refund.

Banned Items:

Firearms, air guns, slingshots, fireworks, chainsaws, and generators.

If found to not be abiding by park rules, guests may be evicted without refund.
